

<b>Daily Activity</b>	<b>Science: Feely Bag</b> Place 3-4 objects of varying textures in a box or paper bag. Invite your child to reach inside and feel the objects. Talk about each item ask they feel them, saying things like “That’s a cotton ball, its very soft.” 	<b>Health/Nutrition: Seeds</b> Talk to your child about seeds. For ex.) where seeds are found, what they are used for, how to help them grow into plants. Plant a seed from any fruit or vegetable in your house. Place it in a damp paper towel and then in a plastic bag (or Ziploc) Watch the roots grow from the seed. **Try to keep bag near the sunlight.	<b>Art: Animal Draw</b> Give your child some paper and writing utensils. Have them draw some animals and make their own zoo! For added fun play some music with animal sounds. 	<b>Fine Motor: Scoop &amp; Bury</b> Provide your child with some sand, dirt, or rice in a bowl and a small shovel. Show your child how to scoop the dirt with the shovel and bury the toy. Then show them how to uncover the toy with the shovel. Have your child try to find a specific color or shape or a toy in the dirt. 	<b>Virtual Fieldtrip: The Monterey Bay Aquarium</b> <a href="https://www.montereybayaquarium.org/animals/live-cams">https://www.montereybayaquarium.org/animals/live-cams</a> Be delighted by the antics of our sea otters or mellow out to the hypnotic drifting of our jellies. <b>Math/ Literacy Activity</b>	<b>Number Match</b> Make a chart with two columns and 10 rows. Write numbers 1-10 going down in the first column. Use small objects to help your child count out that number of objects and place the objects in the other column. 	<b>Memory Math 1-5</b> Cut 10- 2-inch squares of paper to make cards. Write the numbers 1-5 on five cards and on the other 5 write the dots 1 to 5. Turn the cards upside down and mix them up. Play the memory game with these 10 cards. Take turns flipping 2 cards over at a time to make a match. **Keep these cards for a game on Thursday.	<b>Biggest to Smallest</b> Use measuring spoons to explore things small, big, & medium. Let your child have fun stacking the cups or emptying & filling the cups. While they are playing, ask questions and use vocab words: big, medium and small. *Use more than one set of cups if you have them.	<b>Memory Math 5-10</b> Cut 10 2-inch squares of paper to make cards. Write numbers 5-10 on five cards and on the other 5 write dots 5 to 10. Turn the cards upside down and mix them up. Play the memory game with these 10 cards. Take turns flipping 2 cards over at a time to make a match. **Add the other 10 cards from Tuesday after one game.	<b>I Spy</b> Find an old magazine or newspaper and encourage your child to find the first letter in their name as many times as they can.

Have them practice that animal's action & movement. 	<b>Simon Says:</b> Play a game of Simon Says with your child giving them different gross motor functions to do such as: Simon Says "Stand on your tippy toes." "Reach high into the sky with both hands." "Twirl around." 	<b>Obstacle Course</b> Create an obstacle course for your child to enjoy outdoors. Be sure to indicate where Start and Finish is. Ex. Run to the chair, bounce the ball, run to the fence and spin around 3 times, then crawl to the finish line.
