




Music & Movement	<p>Move with Me: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=JoF_d5sgGgc You may need to hold your toddler's hand(s) during this activity.</p> 	<p>Scarf Dancing: Grab a scarf and give it to your toddler, turn on a song and dance together waving the scarf.</p> 	<p>Jump, Run and Shout!: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=hft6uJQIF4g</p> 	<p>Play-time Songs: Sing songs to your toddler about what he/she is doing. Sing his/her name or the name of the toy. See below....Play-Time Song.</p> 	<p>The Walking Song: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=r6cJB7k6eEk</p> 
Daily Activity	<p>Science: Nature Walk: Take your toddler on a walk outside and collect different leaves. Talk to your toddler about the shape, size, color and texture. Save the leaves for an activity next week.</p>	<p>Health/Nutrition: Cook with Me: When preparing a meal for your toddler, have them help measure and mix the ingredients together. Example: Washing fruits for a fruit salad, or making cookies/cake.</p>	<p>Art: Paint with Water: Give your toddler a cup with a little water and a paint brush. Tape paper to the table or outside on the ground. Allow your toddler to paint with the water. Talk to your toddler about with they are doing.</p>	<p>Fine Motor: Fill the Purse: Put a purse, bag and basket on the floor. Gather items for your toddler to put in the purse, bag and basket. Items such as: scarves, toys, small safe items in the home and clothes.</p>	<p>Virtual Fieldtrip: Visit a Butterfly Conservatory! https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=QH_G1dSdPes</p> 
Math/ Literacy Activity	<p>Leaf Sorting: Sort the leaves that you collected on your walk. Sort them by shape, size and, color.</p>	<p>Walk Around the House: As you walk around the house talk about the pieces of furniture in your home and what it is used for. Such as: sofa for sitting or laying down, table for eating or creating, tub for bathing, bed for sleep, etc.</p>	<p>Matching Foods: Find pictures of food or pictures on your electronic device or from a grocery store flyer. Have your child match it with the food in your kitchen and identify it. (refrigerator or pantry). Extend the activity by telling them what you can make/cook with the food item.</p>	<p>Sorting Things: Sort the items you have found around the house for the "Fill the Purse" activity. Sort by kitchen, family room and Bedroom. Exposure to the language is the skill.</p>	<p>Happy and Sad: Find pictures of emotions on your electronic device or draw pictures 😊☹️. Have your toddler identify happy and sad emotions. Take to your toddler about what makes them happy and sad.</p>

Gross Motor: <i>Let's Get Moving!</i>	Play Catch: Show your toddler how to hold out his/her hands and throw a ball directly, and gently, into them. Start out standing close together. As your toddler gets better, move farther away.	Act like animals: Can your toddler stand like a flamingo, squat like a duck, run on all fours like a lion? It's fun to try. Don't forget to make the appropriate animal sounds!	Have fun with balloons: Here's a fun game for a rainy day. Kick a balloon from one side of the room to another. Put a laundry basket on its side and your child can kick it into the basket.	Imitate Each Other: Take turns playing around and mimicking each other. Stick your arms out wide and pretend to fly around and tell your toddler it's his/her turn to be a bird. Then let your toddler lead and you copy.	Toddler Crawl: Using all the chairs in your house, set up an obstacle course for your toddler to go through. Have them crawl under the chairs, if that is too difficult for them then have them go over the chair.
