<b>Daily Activity</b>	<b>Science: Day and Night</b> <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=WrcRKsTYGs">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=WrcRKsTYGs</a> Talk to your baby about things that you do during the day/night. 	<b>Health/Nutrition: Where's the Cereal?</b> Create your own version of the old-fashioned shell game by hiding Cheerios or your babies favorite cereal under a cup and see if your baby can find it. When finished, your baby can enjoy eating their found treat! 	<b>Art: Sensory Play</b> Write your child's name on a blank white sheet of paper. Cut the paper to fit inside a ziploc bag. Put the paper and ketchup, mustard, mayo, and other liquid foods/ sauces into the ziploc bag. Let your baby create art while playing with the bag. You may use paint instead if available.	<b>Fine Motor: 3 Toys &amp; 2 Hands</b> Gather several toy items. Give your baby two toys, one in each hand. Next, offer your baby a third toy. Watch as your child drops one of their toys to grab the new toy you offer. <b>Math/ Literacy Activity</b>	<b>Counting to Ten:</b> Count different items around the house with your baby. Then start over. Choose different or the same items to count again. Afterwards name the items that you two counted. Hold your baby or dance with you baby to have fun together.	<b>Pull the String:</b> Tie strings to the ends of different toys/ items. Lay one of the strings out in front of where your baby is sitting. Show your baby how to pull the string so that the toy moves closer. Switch to a heavier toy so your baby can feel the difference in weight.	<b>Socks Rock:</b> Gather socks. Take them apart and arrange the socks so that the matches are not directly next to each other. Help your baby find the matches to the socks. Talk about why the socks match. 	<b>Reading:</b> Read a story to your baby. Pick your favorite book or your baby's favorite book. Remember to talk about what you and your baby see on each page. 	<b>Tummy Reading:</b> Place your baby on their tummy ( <i>younger babies may only be able to handle a minute or two on their tummy but it is important to provide some tummy time to infants every day</i> ). Place a book in front of your baby. Read and describe the pictures.

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<b>Gross Motor:</b> <b>Let's Get Moving!</b>	<b>This Little Piggy:</b> As your baby is laying on the floor play, "This Little Piggy" with baby's fingers. <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Y236-eGwLd4">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Y236-eGwLd4</a> 	<b>Five Little Ducks:</b> Dance around with your baby like a duck. Place some distance between you and your baby. Then use the sheet to create a parachute over you and your baby. Laugh and play with your baby. <b>Do not leave the sheet on your baby's face.</b>	<b>Be A-Maze-ing:</b> Make an obstacle course out of light sofa cushions, pillows, or boxes on a carpeted floor. Invite your baby to crawl over or in between them. Talk to your baby and call his or her name to follow as you move through the course.	<b>Tummy Tickle :</b> Materials: Blanket. Can be done inside / outside. Place your baby on their back. Tickle your baby's tummy. Make silly sounds and repeat your baby's sounds as you play.
