

Daily Activity	Science: Read a book about flowers or a book about plants to your baby. Talk to your baby about the pictures on each page. 	Health/Nutrition: Nutrition at Different Stages https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=3S1wU7xHVGM	Art: Place ketchup and mustard on a piece of paper or on a plate and let your child finger paint. 	Fine Motor: Put a graspable object in your baby's hand (like a rattle) and pull on it very gently. Repeat, encourage your baby to squeeze the object to keep you from taking it away. Math/ Literacy Activity	Shapes: Pick an item to stack or explore with your baby. Talk about the colors & shapes of each. Move the item different ways to engage your baby and describe what you're doing. For example, "I'm moving the block up."	Stacking: You and your baby can stack items together. This could include plastic bowls, blocks, boxes, or pillows. Any item that stacks and is safe to stack will work. Count the items as you stack each one. 	Counting: Count to ten with your baby then start over and count one more time. Make it fun as you count to ten! You can pick your baby up and lift your baby up and down carefully as you count to ten with your baby. You can also rock your baby back and forth as you count to ten. 	Baby Claps: This is a hand clapping game where you play and clap with your baby. You and your baby switch between a normal clap and a two-handed clap with each other. This fun clapping game will help your child learn about patterns.	I Can See You Baby: This fun game is played by covering your face with your hands then taking them away. This teaches your baby that even though he/she cannot see your face, you are still there.

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Gross Motor: <i>Let's Get Moving!</i>	Follow the Sound: While laying on tummy shake a rattle over your baby's head and move it up and down slowly while your infant lifts their heads to look at it.	Reach Baby Reach: While laying on tummy, place an object in front of your infant and have them reach for it. This will help your infant start to crawl. 	Baby Demolition: While laying on tummy have your infant knock over a block structure that you set up. Say – <i>"Do you see the blocks? Look I can stack them on top of each other. Can you knock them over?"</i>	Grab the Toy: Lay your baby on their back and hang a toy over their head. Have them try to grab it. If they get frustrated, move the item a bit closer until they can grab it. 	Play Ball: You can do this inside or outside. Roll a ball to your baby and see if they will roll it back! Or place the ball near your baby and see if your baby will crawl towards the ball.
