




Daily Activity	Science: Plant A Seed Slice a fruit or vegetable in half. Help your child pick out the seeds. Plant the seeds in a wet paper towel inside of a Ziploc bag. Tape the bag to a window that receives lots of sunlight. Watch for the seeds to sprout. 	Health/Nutrition: Eating Healthy During lunch have a discussion with your child about different food groups. Also, talk to your child about how each food item is cooked. 	Art: Leaf Collage Gather different sized leaves, and paper, glue. If you have various art materials like markers, crayons, colorful tissue paper, you can use them to create a collage. After the collage is made discuss some abstract things that you might see. For example, some of the leaves bunch together might look like a pile of leaves in a backyard. 	Fine Motor: Pom Pom Transfer! Have your child transfer pom poms or other small objects from one muffin tin or container to another. Math/ Literacy Activity	Name Writing Splash a small amount of water on a table and rub some bar soap on the water to make a soap paste. Help your child practice writing numbers 0 to 10 or 0 to 20. 	Classification Help your child gather a rock collection. Label 2 pieces of paper big & small. Help your child sort the rocks in each category (big/small). 	Number Line Create a number line with numbers 1-10. Choose an item (ex. Shoes) to count and represent each number on the number line. Talk about each number's name. 	Name Writing Splash a small amount of water on a table and rub some bar soap on the water to make a soap paste. Help your child practice writing their first and last name. 	Color Sorting Gather about 15-20 toys or items in your house that are red, blue or yellow. Have your child sort the toys or items by color using red, blue and yellow paper or 3 different baskets or bowls. (You can use any three colors.) 
	Rock Collection Walk around your yard and collect rocks. Talk about their shape, size and color and texture while collecting them. Count all the rocks that are collected. Allow your child to walk, hop, crawl across the items without touching the floor. Let them help you set up the course. 	Bug Hunt Use a piece of paper to tally how many bugs you found on your hunt. Count the tally marks and write that number on the paper. 	Indoor Skating Use paper plates to glide along on a carpet. Try to imitate speed skaters, hockey players, or figure skaters.
